Grand Chapter Events Thursday – Saturday:

At the present time, despite the flooding of the building and the extent of renovation needed, plans are to hold the Grand Session at PHGL and RGC Masonic Temple. Thus, the basic session information is being provided below. <u>I am sure there will be some adjustments.</u>

Registration forms for chapter and member registration have been emailed to worthy matrons. A registration exempt list has also been emailed. There is no reduced fee if you plan to attend only one day. The registration fee includes the banquet and Gala. There will be a special <u>registration</u> period slotted on <u>Thursday from 2 - 4 pm</u>.

- At the registration desk, members must show a <u>membership card</u> with <u>fees paid in full</u> for 2024. <u>If fees are not posted on tally sheet by Feb 13, the member will not be admitted to attend the session even if registered.</u>
- DGM Barnes and District 8 members will stuff registration bags. Any chapter or member that has items she wants to donate to put in the bags, bring the items to the Temple on February 13, 2023.
- A draft agenda will be sent out before the session.

Memorial Service will be held on Thursday night. Remember this event is open to the public. Invite family and friends. Wear white with white prayer caps, and full regalia.

Trustee Banquet will be held Friday night; the dress wear is semi-formal to formal. Tickets must be purchased with your registration. No tickets sold at the door.
